

A new era of CCTV monitoring, supported by the Vumacam infrastructure, is rolling out in a number of our dedicated areas. Funding for these initiatives is driven by 24/7 Security Services, Residents' Associations and Business Improvement Districts.

What you need to know:

- The CCTV cameras, installed at strategic positions, transmit footage to the 24/7 Security Command Centre.
- There are two types of cameras overview cameras provide a wide-angle view of the area, and Automatic License Plate Recognition (ALPR) cameras are programmed to focus on vehicle number plates.
- The data from the ALPR cameras is compared to various national databases, including the SAPS Stolen Vehicle List.
- The effectiveness of the camera systems lies in the deployment of 24/7 Armed Reaction vehicles who respond and investigate incidents and suspicious behaviour.
- The cameras are set up in such a manner that it does not 'look' into private
 property. The system was created to comply with the proposed Protection of
 Personal Information Act (POPI). The footage is strictly controlled and will only
 be released to SAPS against a valid case number.

PTT RADIOS

As part of 24/7 Security's ongoing investment in technology, we are replacing all our standard two-way radios with new Press To Talk (PTT) radios. These new radios will allow our Command Centre to better monitor and manage communication across all our sites.

PTT radios far exceed the coverage and performance of traditional radio trunking networks. They operate on the GSM cellular network which provides coverage over much larger areas than conventional radios.

The PTT radios provide for real-time tracking and reporting through GPS positioning, they include features such as panic buttons and voice recording, and support effective on-site communication. They also serve as a real-time patrol system.

There is no cost to our clients for this innovative technology upgrade. We will be

communicating directly with customers to arrange for the implementation of the new PTT radios.
