Category:

Theft out of motor vehicle was the main crime committed in the Sector this week.

Times: Times of crimes were mainly between 16:00 to 20:00.

<u>Days</u>: Majority of crimes were committed on Friday.

Pertinent Detail:

In a house robbery incident that occurred at Moorivier Way, Gallo Manor on 2017-09-19 at about 09:30, the complainant was inside the house when she was approached by three males. The suspects ransacked the house and took electronic equipment and jewellery. They then fled the scene. Four suspects were later arrested. Investigation continues.
