Burglary was the main crime committed in the Sector this week.

Times: Times of crimes were mainly between 16:00 to 20:00.

Days: Majority of crimes were committed on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday.

Pertinent Detail:

In a robbery incident that occurred at N1 Freeway and Rivonia Road, Rivonia on 2017-09-30 at about 14:10, the complainant was waiting for a taxi when approached by two males, one armed with a firearm. The suspects were driving a white Toyota Corolla. The victim was robbed of his belongings. The suspects fled the scene. Investigation continues.
