Sandton Precinct Crime Trends - Period: 2017-08-07 to 2017-08-13

SECTOR 1:

(Edenburg; Gallo Manor; Khyber Rock; Rivonia; Sunninghill; Woodlands; Woodmead)

Category:

Theft out of motor vehicle was the main crime committed in the Sector this week.

Times: Times of crimes were mainly between 16:00 to 20:00.

Days: Majority of crimes were committed on Tuesday.

Pertinent Detail:

In a carjacking incident that occurred at Rivonia Boulevard, Rivonia on 2017-08-08 at about 12:15 the complainant parked the vehicle. Whilst busy in the boot he was approached by two black males. He was robbed of the car keys and they drove off in his vehicle. Investigation continues.

Category:

Robbery was the main crime committed in the Sector this week.

Times: Times of crimes were mainly between 16:00 to 20:00.

Days: Majority of crimes were committed on Tuesday.

Pertinent Detail:

In a house robbery incident that occurred at Hans Crescent, Bryanston on 2017-08-08 at about 10:45 the complainant was inside the house when approached by three black males. The suspects ransacked the house. They took jewellery and electronic equipment. The suspects fled the scene. Investigation continues.

Robbery was the main crime committed in the Sector this week.

Times: Times of crimes were mainly between 08:00 to 12:00.

Days: Majority of crimes were committed on Thursday and Friday.

Pertinent Detail:

In a house robbery incident that occurred at Crassula Crescent, Morningside on 2017-08-07 at about 02:00, the complainant was inside the house when approached by three black males wearing balaclavas all armed with firearms. The suspects took cash and electronic equipment. Investigation continues.

SECTOR 4:

(Buccleuch; Eastgate; Kelvin; Kelvin View; Kramerville; Marlboro North; Wendywood; Wesco Park)

Category:

Robbery was the main crime committed in the Sector this week.

Times: Times of crimes were mainly between 16:00 to 17:00.

Days: Majority of crimes were committed on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Pertinent Detail:

In a carjacking incident that occurred at South and Edison Roads, Wendywood on 2017-08-08 at about 12:20, the complainant was stationary at the robot when approached by three black males. She was forced out of her vehicle and the suspects got inside and drove off. Investigation continues.
