Sandton Precinct Crime Trends - Period: 2018-08-20 to 2018-08-26

SECTOR 1:

(Edenburg; Gallo Manor; Khyber Rock; Rivonia; Sunninghill; Woodlands; Woodmead)

Category:

Theft out of motor vehicle was the main crime committed in the Sector this week.

Times: Times of crimes were mainly between 08:00 to 09:00 and 15:00 to 18:00.

Days: Majority of crimes were committed on Wednesday and Thursday.

Pertinent Detail:

In a house robbery incident that occurred at Spitfire Street and Tudor Avenue, Sunninghill on 2018-08-21 at about 12:50, the victim was inside the garage when approached by an unknown male. The suspect ransacked the house and took electronic equipment and drove off in victim's vehicle. Investigation continues.
