Category:

Vehicle related crime was the main contributor in the Sector this week.

Times: Times of crimes were mainly between 16:00 to 20:00.

Days: Majority of crimes were committed on Thursday.

Pertinent Detail:

In a house robbery incident that occurred at Rodwilla Road, Edenburg on 2018-09-06 at about 22:00, the victims were inside the house when approached by two males. They were tied up. The suspects ransacked the house and took cash, clothes and electronic equipment. They then fled the scene. Investigation continues.
