Recommendations:

- The properties on the corner of the SANRAL reseve and Riley Road still to be encouraged to install perimeter protection of some sort
- Fig 2: The barbed wire starnds have been cut and should be repaired asap.
- The dead tree across a section of the barbed wire fencing ws removed and that section of fence repired.
- The perimeter fencing remains compromised by overgrowth of vegetation, this all needs to be cut back and maintained regularly so as to not compromise the areas security.
- The missing palisade pole at the Eskom transformer remains a concern, however the padlock on the inside gate remains in tact.
- The storm drain links the squatter camp across the road to the SANRAL reserve remains a concern. I would suggest and engineer have a look at it and advise is there is anything that can be done to "human proof the tunnel.

Other than the Bush Sleeper we found near the highway there was no new evidence found of criminal activity in the
