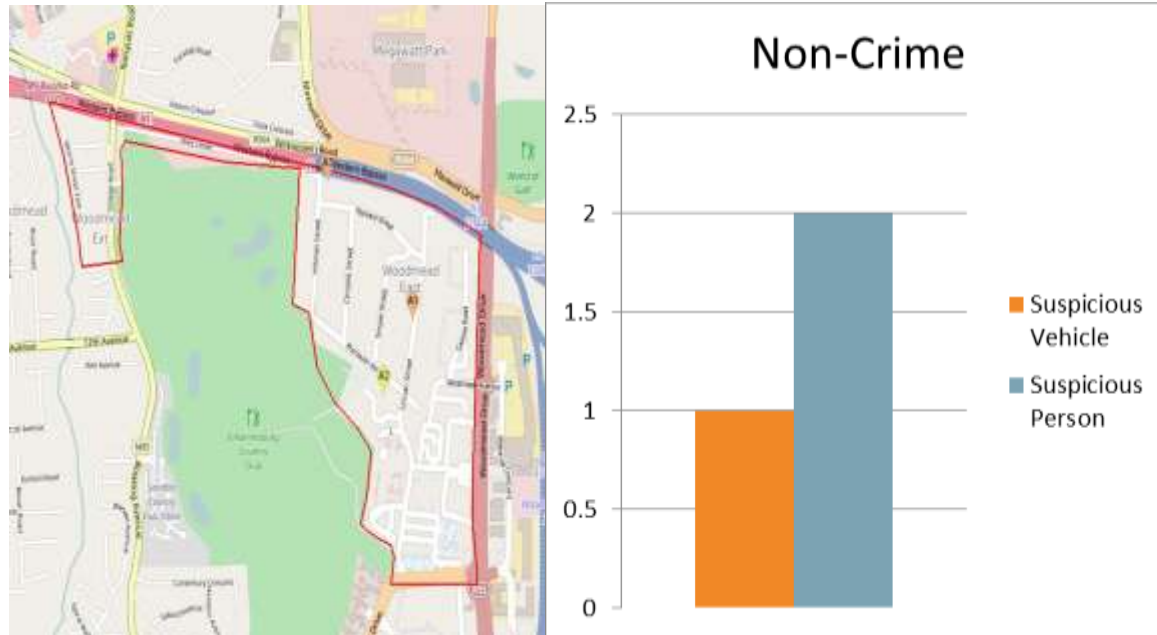

The client Mr McCullum of Unit 2 pressed the panic when he saw that the door was opened in Unit 1. B75 and B06 were dispatched. On arrival they were informed about the break-in that had occurred at Unit 1. They went in to investigate and discovered that two electric fence wires were cut off on top of the wall to gain access. The outside electric box situated on the side of the road, outside the complex had its padlock changed and the switch had tripped. Jewellery, car keys and other items were stolen. It was suspected that a break-in had occurred a few days ago. The client was away since the 9th of April 2017. Mr McCullum who is also the key holder contacted the client, the client informed him that he was aware of the break-in and was on his way back home. SAPS was informed, Constable Nemutanzhela; Constable Mahla and Constable Mphahlela attended the scene driving a state marked vehicle registration number BTC 392 B.

It was 15:30 on the 19th of April 2017 when Mr Anthony Southgate aged 44 was sitting in his blue Porsche 911 registration number FD 03 RT GP waiting for his friend Mr Hayden Lambert to arrive home. While sitting in his vehicle two unknown vehicles pulled up at the front and back of his Porsche. The make of vehicles are unknown. One small vehicle with two doors and the other was a white Sedan no registration number was given. One African male got out of the small vehicle and pointed Mr Southgate with a firearm. Mr Southgate was pulled out of his vehicle and forced into the suspect's vehicle. The vehicle drove off and the other suspect drove Mr Southgate's vehicle. Mr Southgate was robbed of his Tag Heuer; cell phone and R2000 cash. Later he was dropped off at the Corner Oldens Way and North Way, Kelvin at 17:00. He opened a case at Sandton Police Station at 20:30. The case number is Case No: 760/04/2017.

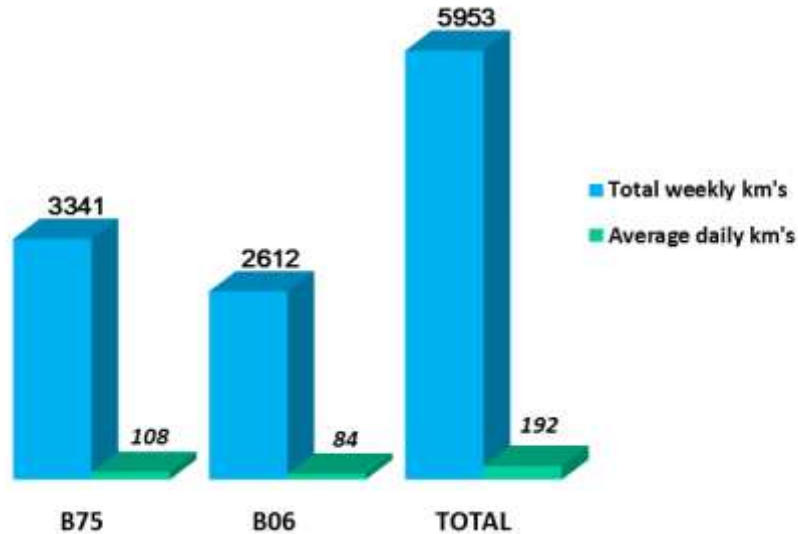

The graph indicates the amount of kilometres travelled by the vehicle for the month as well as an average per day.

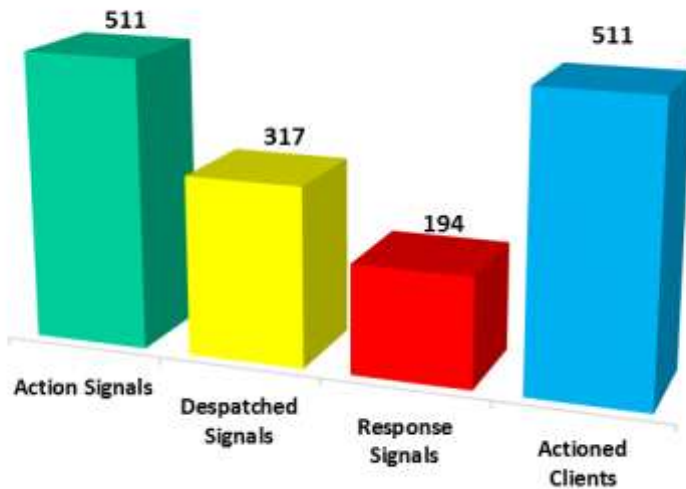
