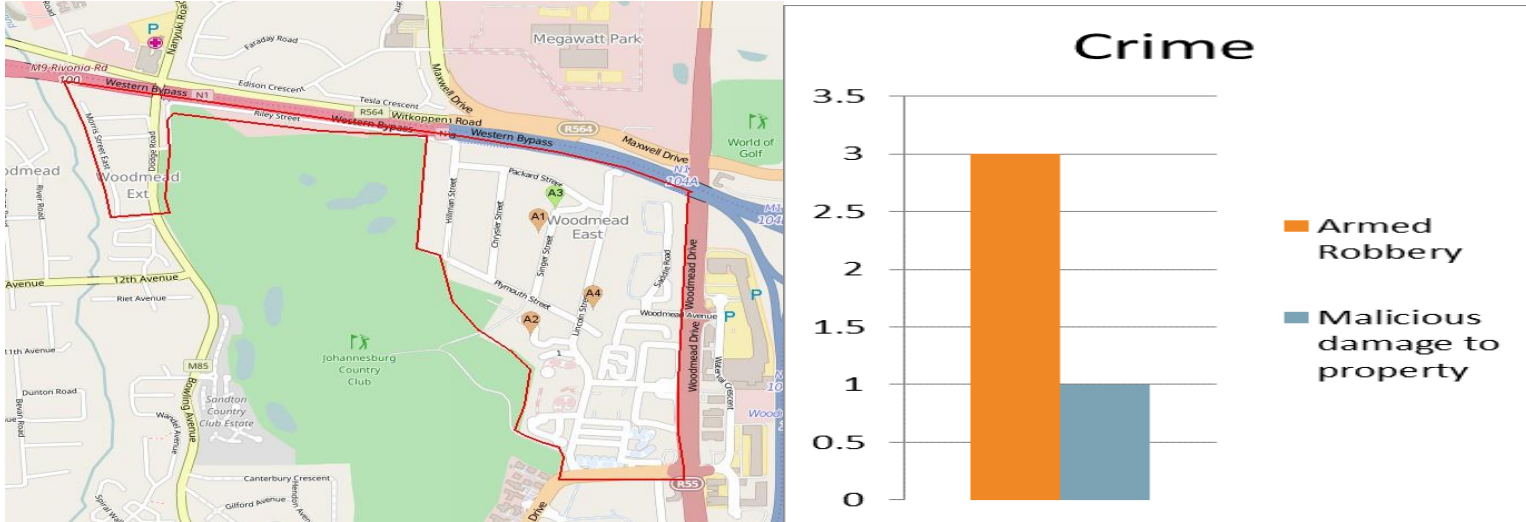

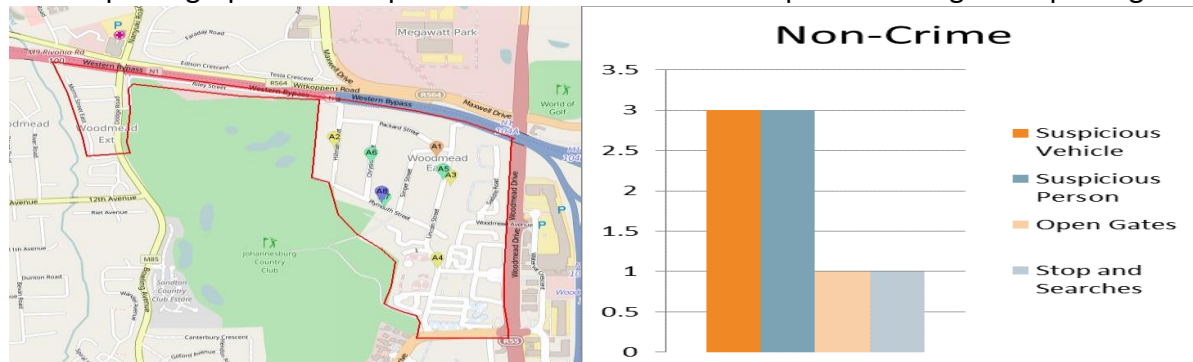

It was reported that 3 African male suspects jumped the wall to gain access into the premises, they found 2 children sitting by the swimming pool, forced them into the house at a gun point. They found 3 other people inside the house all of them were tied up with cable ties and shoe laces in the parent's bedroom. 7x cellphones; 2x laptops; jewellery and clothing were reported stolen.</p> <p>When B75 was on his way to respond he came across the suspects and they started shooting at him and he retaliated by firing shots, but no one was reported injured. The suspects then fled the scene along the highway dropping a bag containing jewellery; clothes and sneakers. SAPS informed, Sergeant Dikobe and Detective Mathebula arrived on scene driving a Nissan Bakkie Hardbody registration number BSX 619 B.</p> <p>IPhone was traced to under Marlboro Bridge where an exchange of fire took place. The suspects jumped over the waste dump perimeter, the phone was traced</p>
Armed Robbery	2017-06-16	03:39:00	2	0	0	A2	The Pass Lincoln Street	<p>A CPS Security Guard was reported attacked and robbed by 2 African male intruders while on patrol at Lincoln Street. It was about 03:20 when the incident occurred. He was hit with an iron bar on his back. They searched him, took his wallet with the amount of R1800 cash. They then fled the scene. He was reported not badly injured.</p> <p>It was reported that they used a step ladder to gain access inside the complex coming from golf course side.</p> <p>911 Netcare informed, Sirbert (paramedics) attended the scene driving an ambulance registration number DB 47 BV GP. They helped him, but he was not taken to hospital as he was not badly injured. Mr James promised to take the Security Officer to a private hospital.</p> <p>SAPS was informed, Constable Mogale and Constable Mphahlele attended the scene driving a marked SAPS vehicle registration number BTS 524 B.</p> <p>A case of armed robbery was opened.</p>

The client Mrs Anne Nicholson confirmed that at about 07:30 the domestic worker came to the kitchen and when she opened the door she was surprised by 2 African male suspects one armed with a firearm and the other armed with a kitchen knife. They then ordered her to the main house, but she managed to press the panic button and later she heard reaction team voices outside, by that time the suspects were still in the house and she screamed for help through the window. When control room phoned she was denied answering the phone. Suspects demanded car keys, garage remote control and the client's phone. Mrs Nicholson and the domestic worker were taken to the bathroom where they were tied up with shoe laces and a t-shirt, they blind folded them and one kept on checking them while the other ransacked the house loading onto vehicle. Hearing that the reaction team was at the gate they then fled the scene by jumping the wall at the back of the house into the business complex of Woodmead Drive.

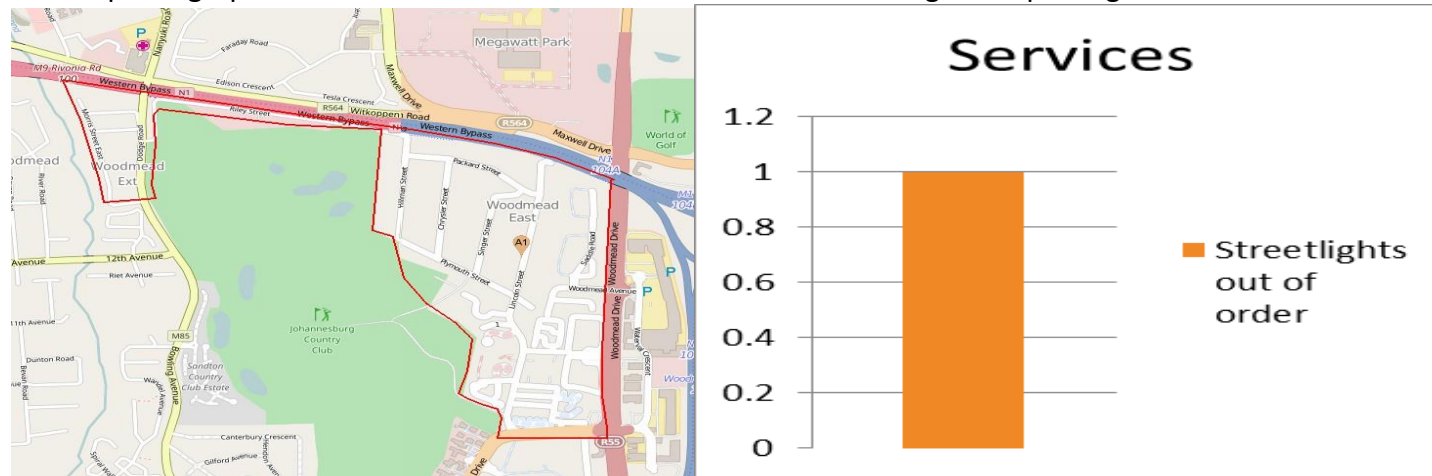

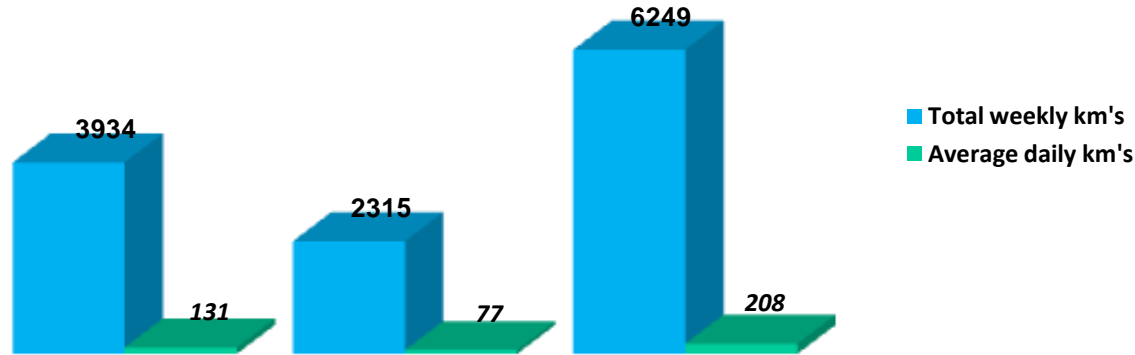

The graph indicates the amount of kilometres travelled by the vehicle for the month as well as an average per day.

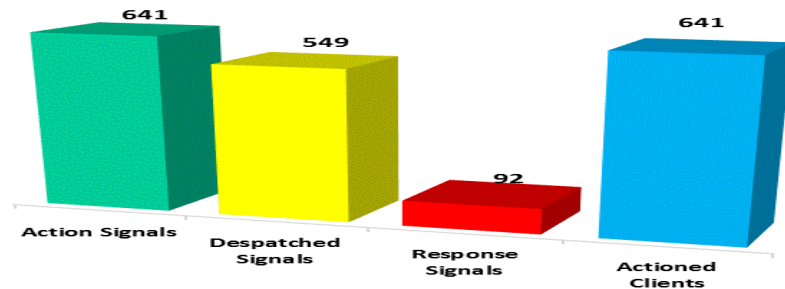
