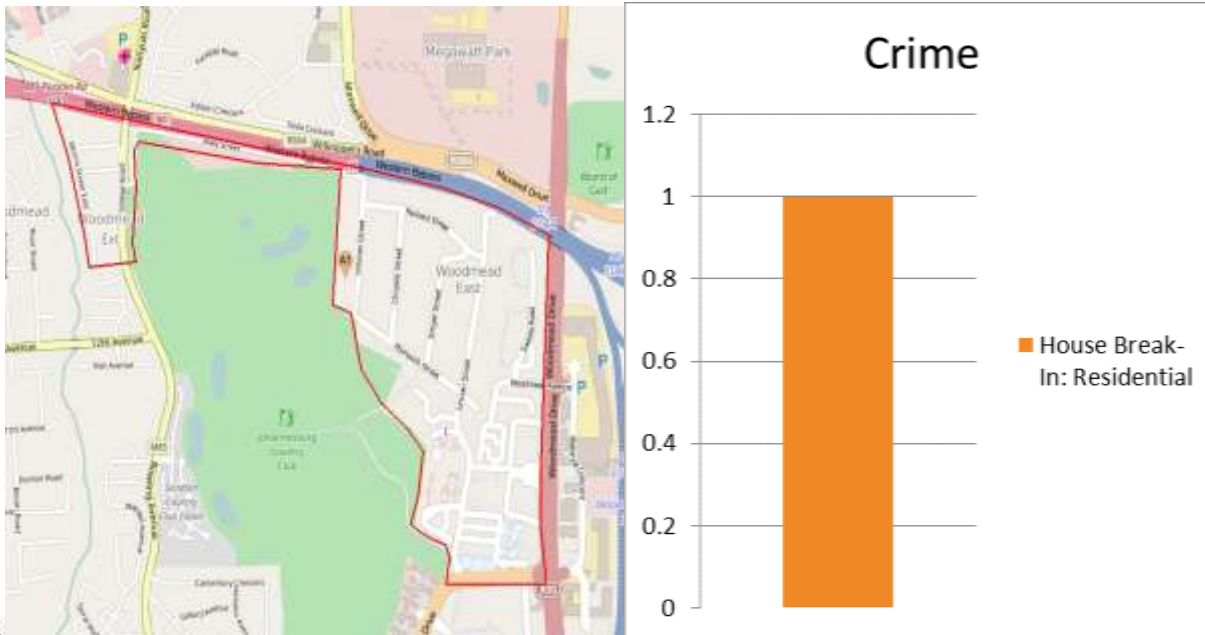

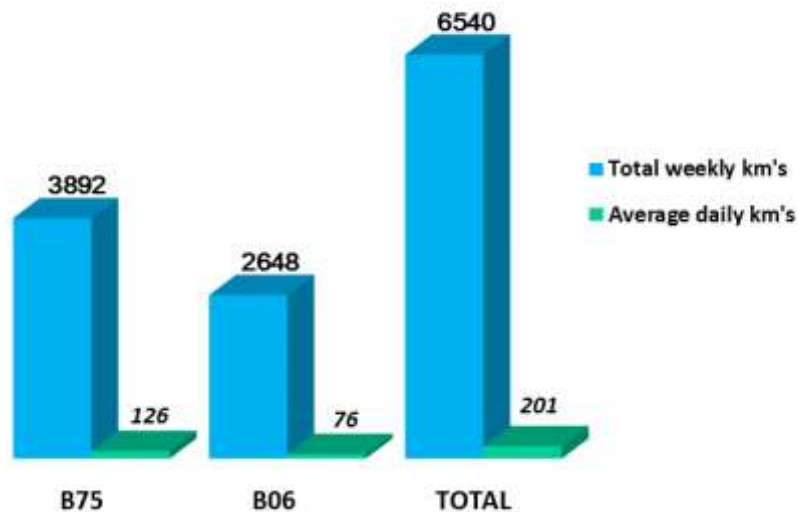

The graph indicates the amount of kilometres travelled by the vehicle for the month as well as an average per day.

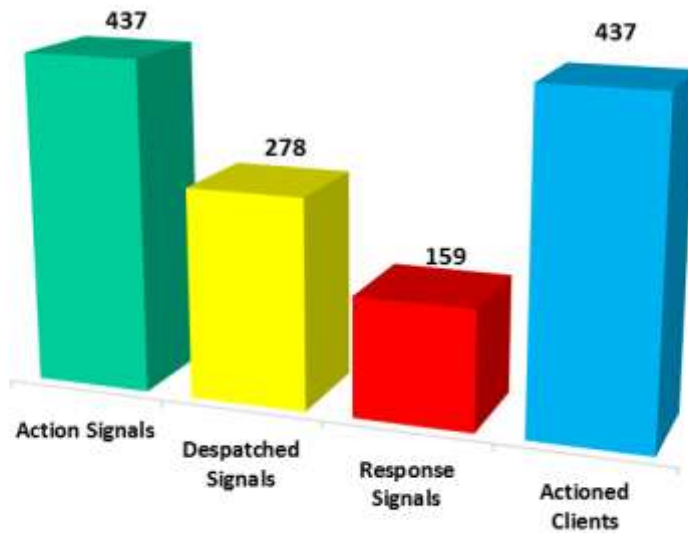
